**Dr. Barbara Rasco** an Associate Professor with the Dept. of Food Science and Human Nutrition at Washington State University, is an Institute of Food Technologists distinguished lecturer. Dr. Rasco has a BSE in biochemical engineering from the University of Pennsylvania, a Ph.D. in Food Science from the University of Massachusetts and a J.D. from Seattle University. She Chaired the Food Laws and Regulations Division of IFT in 1998. Dr. Rasco is licensed to practice law in the State of Washington and in Federal Court. Dr. Rasco is nationally recognized in food safety, food law and products liability. She is also an active researcher with over 60 publications primarily in seafood and cereal products science and technology.

**Kenneth D. Gisborne**, CPP - Director of Strategic Development - 3Si Risk Strategies. Gisborne is a retired RCMP who has been a consultant in the private security industry for the past 15 years. He is a Certified Protection Professional through the American Society for Industrial Security International and a licensed Security Consultant and Private Investigator in the Province of British Columbia, and holds a "SECRET" Security Clearance with the Canadian Federal Government. He has been qualified forensic security expert since 1981, and has been providing forensic security expertise in Canada, the United States and in Hong Kong since that time.
